

# **NORMAL PROCEDURES**

### **Motor Starting Checklist**

- Ensure motor/propeller area is clear of swimmers
- Turn battery switch on
- Trim motor down
- If beached, only lower motor enough to get propeller submerged
- Verify safety lanyard in proper position
- Verify throttle is in neutral
- Turn key until motor runs

## **Underway Checklist**

- Verify bow (front) gate is closed
- Ensure all passengers are seated
- · Ensure all lines are onboard and secured
- Operate in shallow water with motor tilted up
- When water depth is unknown proceed slowly and with caution

## **Docking Checklist**

- Place fenders on dock side of boat
- Approach beach slowly
- Utilize minimum throttle (forward idle works well)
- When close to parking position, prepare to utilize reverse to slow and stop
- Tie front and rear cleats to dock

## **Beaching Checklist**

- Have all passengers mid-ship
- Trim motor up so that propeller is just submerged
- Approach beach slowly
